

YOUR MIDDLESEX MEMBERSHIP - IMPORTANT INFORMATION

MEMBERSHIP CARDS

Your Membership card must have a photo on it to be valid for the 2025 season. If your card does not have a photo, please call the office to arrange this or come to the Middlesex reception on a match day.

Your 2025 Middlesex membership card will gain you access to all Middlesex home County Championship, One-Day Cup and T20 group stage matches at Lord's, Merchant Taylors' School and Radlett CC.

Members will just need to produce their card at the entrance gate to the ground for scanning and you will be admitted.

If you lose your membership card, please call or email the membership office and we can arrange a duplicate card for you (£5 charge).

SEASON GUEST PASSES

Season Guest Passes can be purchased via the Members' portal, or by calling the office. They are valid for a member to bring one guest in to all home County Championship and One-Day Cup (group stage) games, **but only when the Member is present. Season Guest passes are not valid when the named member is not present.**

MEMBERS' PORTAL

MEMBERS' SEATING AREAS

Lord's – The Pavilion, Allen Stand, Middlesex Room and Warner Stand are Members' and Friends' enclosures and are open at all Middlesex home matches (un-allocated seating). During T20 games, members may only sit in the Members' seating areas.

Please note, No unaccompanied Youth Member will be admitted to the Pavilion and children under the age of 12, even if accompanied, are not permitted into the Pavilion on any Middlesex match day.

Babies under the age of six months may be brought into the Pavilion. They must be carried in arms as there is not sufficient space for buggies inside the building.

Radlett – The Clubhouse is allocated as a Member and guest only area.

Merchant Taylors' School – No allocated member area



DRESS CODES

Lord's

Dress regulations vary dependent on the location within the Ground and match day. Religious, traditional or national dress, or service uniform, is permitted for all matches. Any exceptions to the Dress Regulations must have prior authorisation, in writing, from the Pavilion Manager. MCC reserves the right to refuse entry to any person considered unsuitably attired.

Pavilion

A formal standard of dress applies in the Pavilion on all match days. For gentlemen, this includes a tailored jacket or blazer with a collared shirt and tie or cravat, tailored trousers and socks that cover the ankle. For ladies this includes a smart dress, jumpsuit, skirt or trousers with a smart top or blouse. Footwear appropriate to a formal setting is also applicable. Denim, dilapidated or offensive garments will not be permitted.

Allen Stand and Middlesex Room

The Allen stand redevelopment project starts in early September 2025 and so

for the final two County Championship games of the season, the Allen stand and Middlesex Room will not be available.

For these two matches, we will move the "Middlesex Room" to the President's Suite on level two of the Grandstand

Access to the ground via the Grace gate access will also be affected, Please look out for our emails with more specific information on member facilities and ground access which will be sent in August and information for members will be posted on the website.

Members' Friends' Enclosures

There are no Dress Regulations in place for Middlesex Matches within Members' Friends' Enclosures.

Out-Grounds – No dress code applies to the members areas at any out-grounds.

BRINGING GUESTS INTO MEMBERS' AREAS

Lord's – County Championship & One-Day Cup

Adult members may sign one Guest into the Pavilion and two Guests into the Members' Friends' Enclosures after payment of the ground admission

charge. Members' who have used their Season Guest Pass to bring a Guest to Lord's may also sign this Guest into the Pavilion or Members' Friends' Enclosures.

Please note, Youth members are not permitted to sign guests into the Pavilion.

Lord's – T20

Middlesex Members wishing to bring Guests, must purchase either a Pavilion Admission ticket (max 1 per match) for their guest, which allows them to sit in the Pavilion, or a Rover Ticket (max 6 per match) for their guests, which allows them to sit in the Members' Friends' Enclosures. All seating in Members' areas is unallocated, so early arrival at the ground to take your seats is recommended.

Please note, Youth members are not permitted to purchase Pavilion Admission Tickets.

PURCHASING GUEST TICKETS

Lord's – All tickets for matches at Lord's are now sold online, available to purchase for guests via the Lord's Ticket website at tickets.lords.org.

MEMBERS COMPLIMENTARY GUEST TICKETS

Middlesex adult members are entitled to apply for two complimentary tickets each season, to bring a guest to any day of a County Championship or One-Day Cup group stage game at Lord's, Radlett or Merchant Taylors' School. Please email enquiries@middlesexccc.com with the date of the match you require a complimentary ticket for, and the ticket(s) will be emailed to you at least 48 hours, before the start of the fixture.

ACCESSIBLE VIEWING AREAS

Lord's has dedicated viewing facilities for members with accessibility issues and any disabilities. For details of the Lord's accessibility policy, please visit lords.org/accessibility.

Any members who require ambulant disabled access, wheelchair area tickets or have any other specific requirements, please indicate this when registering their Lord's client reference code with the Middlesex events team.

Out-grounds – There are dedicated accessible seating areas, please speak to a steward on entry to be guided to a suitable seating area.

ALCOHOL POLICY

Lord's – All Middlesex home matches - Members may bring alcohol into Lord's, limited to the below (per person)

Wine/Champagne – max 750ml bottle

Beer or Cider – max 2 cans/bottles of 500ml each

Pre-mixed aperitifs – max 2 cans of 330ml each

Radlett & Merchant Taylors' School - County Championship & One-Day Cup matches. Alcohol policy same as Lord's
Merchant Taylors' School – T20 matches - NO alcohol or glass bottles are permitted to be brought into the ground in accordance with ECB regulations.

CAR PARKING

Lord's - Parking is extremely limited at Lord's and cannot be guaranteed. Enquiries about accessible parking should be made to the MCC Club Services Department on 0207 432 1000 or email clubservices@mcc.org.uk.

Radlett – Members' parking is available priced at £3, follow signs for public car parking. Tickets can be purchased in advance by visiting the out-ground ticket page on the Middlesex website.

For accessible parking, please follow the signs to Players and Officials parking and a steward will direct you to the area reserved for those who require accessible parking.

Merchant Taylors' School - Members' parking is available priced at £3, follow sign for public car parking. Tickets can be purchased in advance by visiting the out-ground ticket page on the Middlesex website.

For accessible parking, please advise the steward at the main gate you require an accessible parking place, and you will be directed to the Blue badge parking area.

MULTI-FAITH ROOM

Lord's - The Multi-Faith Room is a multi-use area that includes a multi-faith space and, gendered ablution

facilities. The facility is located in the Pavilion basement.

Radlett & Merchant Taylors' School Multi-Faith spaces are provided at all out-grounds. Please ask a steward for further information when you arrive at the grounds.

SENSORY ROOM

Lord's - The Sensory Room situated in the Tavern Stand or Pavilion basement, provides a safe and calming space for those with neurodivergent needs that may be finding the atmosphere overwhelming. The room can be used by Members and their guests and is available on a first-come, first-served basis. Further information can be obtained by contacting MCC Club Services on 0207 432 1000.

GENERAL INFORMATION/ ETIQUETTE

Lord's Pavilion:

- Refrain from moving in and out of your seat during the course of an over;
- Photography is prohibited in all areas within the Pavilion on match days;
- Players' privacy should be respected at all times, ensuring ample distance is maintained between players and Members throughout the Pavilion;
- The seeking of players' and officials autographs in the Pavilion or during practice sessions is forbidden;
- Food and drinks are not to be consumed in non-bar areas within

the building, such as corridors, stairwells and the Long Room.

- Mobile devices are not to be used for making phone calls, taking photos or videos anywhere inside the Pavilion on Match Days.

Smoking / Vaping - is not permissible in any seating areas at any Middlesex home ground. There are designated smoking / vaping areas appropriately marked. Please ask a steward if you are unsure where these areas are.

Bars – Generally, on Middlesex County Championship and One-Day Cup games, the Long Room, Members' Bar and Bowlers Bar in the Pavilion are open, plus the Middlesex Room (Allen Stand) and Balcony Bar (Warner Stand).

Food – Hot food is served in the Long Room Bar and Middlesex Room and no booking is required.

MERCHANT TAYLORS' SCHOOL

Driving: Merchant Taylors' School is situated in Moor Park (private residential estate). The address is:

Merchant Taylors' School, Sandy Lodge, Northwood, Middlesex HA6 2HT.

Nearest Tube: Moor Park (Metropolitan Line) 7-minute walk

At the exit turnstiles, double back on yourself, sharp right along the walkway under the railway line. Go up the stairs and turn sharp left through the barrier onto the path through the spinney that is parallel to the railway. At the end, bear left along Askew Road, cross the road at the zebra crossing and walk on 50 yards until you see the school gates on your right. Walk up the Long Drive and you will see the ground entrance gates on the cricket field on your left.
