

## A GUIDE TO LORD'S

#### **DRESS CODE - IN THE PAVILION**

A formal standard of dress applies in the Pavilion at all times. Members, guests and visitors are required to observe it.

Gentlemen: tailored jacket or blazer; collared shirt that is tucked into tailored trousers, chinos, corduroys or moleskin trousers; a tie or cravat; and formal shoes with socks which cover the ankle.

Ladies: dress, skirt or tailored trousers with a smart top or blouse, or other clothing that is appropriately formal. Formal shoes, boots or sandals must be worn.

### DRESS IN THE MEMBERS' FRIENDS' ENCLOSURES

Members and their guests are expected to maintain an acceptable standard of dress while in the Members' Friends' Enclosures. To avoid any embarrassment at the entrance to the enclosures, Members must ensure that their attire, and that of their guests, is appropriate for the area.

The minimum standard of dress to enter the Members' Friends' Enclosures is "smart casual" for both sexes. Jackets are not required, but gentlemen sixteen years and over must wear collared shirts (even when a collared sweater or jacket is worn on top) at all times in the stands. Shorts and trousers must be tailored, although denim is acceptable. The following items of clothing are **unacceptable**:

#### Gentlemen

Shirts which do not have a collar (unless worn by under-sixteens), including crew-neck shirts (polo-neck shirts are acceptable) | Shirts which do not have collar (unless worn by under-sixteens), including crew-neck suits (polo-neck shirts are acceptable) | T-shirts or singlets | Torn, ripped or unclean clothing Football, running, athletic, cycling, tennis or other shorts worn for playing sport | Tracksuits | Garments in military camouflage colours | Beachwear | Beach-style flip-flop shoes.

### Ladies

Torn, ripped or unclean clothing Football, running, athletic, cycling, tennis or other shorts worn for playing sport | Tracksuits | Garments in military camouflage colours Bikini tops or tops/dresses showing bare midriff | Beachwear | Beachstyle flip-flop shoes | Bare feet, bare torsos and anyone wearing dilapidated or offensive garments of any kind will not be permitted under any circumstances.

Notwithstanding the dress standards outlined above, M.C.C. reserves the right to refuse entry to any person considered unsuitably attired.

### ALCOHOL POLICY

Small quantities of alcohol may be brought into Lord's Ground, but is limited to the equivalent of

- one bottle of wine or Champagne (max. 750ml), or
- two cans/bottles of beer/cider (max. 500ml each), or
- two cans of premixed aperitifs (max. 330ml each)

per spectator.

Bottles of spirits or fortified wines will not be allowed into the Ground.

### T20 BLAST – PAVILION ADMISSION & ROVER TICKETS

Middlesex members must sit in the Pavilion or Members' Friends' Enclosures for these matches unless you have specifically purchased a general public ticket. General public tickets will also NOT allow members' guests to sit with you in the members' areas.

Middlesex members (excluding County Members and , Teen & Junior) who wish to bring a guest (s) to any T20 Blast matches at Lord's will need to purchase either a Pavilion admission ticket (maximum ONE ticket for each T20 Blast match) or Rover ticket (maximum FOUR tickets for each match). This will allow your guest to sit in the Lord's Pavilion (if you have purchased a Pavilion admission ticket) or the Members' Friends' enclosures (Allen, Lower Tavern or Warner Stand) if you have purchased a Rover ticket.

### **PAVILION ADMISSION TICKETS**

For T20 Blast matches, Middlesex members (excluding County Members, Teen and Junior Members) may introduce ONE guest (who must be in possession of a nontransferable PAVILION ADMISSION TICKET) into the Pavilion at Lord's.

Please note: Pavilion Admission tickets are subject to availability, so it is advised they are purchased well in advance (on sale from 4th March 2019). Middlesex Junior members are NOT allowed to introduce guests into the Pavilion at Lord's, so are unable to purchase Pavilion Admission Tickets. Teen members over the age of 12 can be admitted to the Pavilion, but are unable to purchase Pavilion Admission Tickets.

### **ROVER TICKETS**

Middlesex members (excluding County Members, Junior & Teen Members) are entitled to purchase up to FOUR Rover Tickets for each T20 Blast match, which will entitle the holder entry into the Members' Friends' Enclosures at Lord's (this DOES NOT include the Pavilion).

# MIDDLESEX CCC 2019 TICKET PRICES AT LORD'S

Please note: If your friends and family purchase tickets for the general public stands, your Middlesex membership will NOT entitle you to sit with them in the public stands at T20 Blast matches at Lord's. Junior & Teen members are unable to purchase Rover tickets.

### SIGNING GUESTS IN FOR NON-T20 BLAST MATCHES

Middlesex members (excluding Junior & Teen Members) are entitled to sign one guest into the Lord's Pavilion for all Specsavers County Championship and Royal London One-Day Cup group matches and up to two guests into the Member's and Friend's Enclosures, after payment of the ground admission charge.

### CAR PARKING

Car parking at Lord's is extremely limited, but is available to members of MCC or Middlesex with special requirements and must be booked in advance. To make a booking please call MCC Club Facilities on 020 7616 8653. **Please note:** car parking is not guaranteed.

### LATE GATE ADMISSION CHARGES

All spectators shall be admitted for half the adult price from the beginning of the scheduled tea interval on all match days except the final day of matches which are of more than one day's duration. In relation to one-day matches any decision relating to charges for late-gate would be made as a consequence of weather conditions and the state of the match. Under normal circumstances there would not be a late-gate for one-day matches.

### DIRECTIONS

Tube: Several London Underground stations are within walking distance of Lord's; they include St John's Wood (Jubilee Line), Warwick Avenue (Bakerloo Line) and Baker Street (Bakerloo, Circle, Jubilee, Hammersmith & City and Metropolitan lines). **Bus:** LT 6, 13, 16, 46, 82, 98, 113, 139, 189 and 274 pass close to the ground. Also London Country Coaches (Green Line) 719, 757, 768 and 797 from home counties pass near the ground - 020 7222 1234. **Car:** The ground is currently outside the Central London Congestion Zone.

From North: from M1, junction 1, follow signs to A5 (Edgware Road), continue on this road towards London, at traffic lights junction with A5205 turn left into St John's Wood Road.

From South: from M23/M25 iunction 7/8 continue north on A23 into London to junction with A203 (Stockwell Road), follow signs to Vauxhall Bridge, cross the Bridge and take A202 (Vauxhall Bridge Road) to Victoria Station, bear right on to Wilton Road, follow signs to Hyde Park Corner (A302) (Grosvenor Place), continue up Park Lane to Marble Arch, then take Edgware Road (A5) to St John's Wood, at traffic lights, junction with A5205 turn right into St. John's Wood Road. From East: from M25 junction 27

**From East:** from M25 junction 27 continue south on M11 to junction 4 (A406) (North Circular Road),

continue west on A406 to Brent Cross, junction with A41 (Hendon Way), continue on A41 to Wellington Road. **From West:** from M4 at Chiswick flyover, turn left on to A406 (Gunnersbury Avenue), at traffic lights turn right on to A4000 (Gunnersbury Lane), continue on A4000 to junction with A40 (Western Avenue), turn right and continue on A40 (Westway) on to A40(M), continue on to Marylebone Road, turn left on to B507 (Lisson Grove), turn right on to A5205 (St John's Wood Road) **From M40**: from M40 continue on A40 (Western Avenue) then as for M4.

### **IMPORTANT NOTICES**

The use of radio sets inside the ground is prohibited except in conjunction with an earpiece. No dogs shall be allowed inside the ground, with the exception of assistance dogs.

The Executive Board reserves the right to examine membership cards at any time. Membership cards are non transferable and if used by any other person, may result in the suspension of the member (Rule 11.1). Autograph & Photograph Hunting Seeking to interrupt or delay players or match officials while entering or leaving the field of play or whilst passing through the Pavilion is not permitted. Members are asked to desist from seeking autographs or photographs in the Pavilion. Members are asked to desist from entering the ground on major match preparation days in order to seek autographs or photographs whilst cricketers are practicing.

## IMPORTANT MEMBERS' INFORMATION AT LORD'S

### MIDDLESEX MEMBERS MATCH DAY PRIVILEGES

A member shall on production of his/her current membership card be entitled to the privileges listed as follows:

**1.** County Championship Matches (a) Home matches at Lord's: Admission to the Ground, Pavilion, Middlesex Room and Members' Friends' Enclosures and other public enclosures subject to availability. In addition, the right to introduce ONE quest or junior member (over 12) to the Pavilion and TWO guests to the Members' Friends' Enclosures, (See Notes i, ii, iii, iv, v & vi). (b) Home Matches at other Grounds: Admission to the Ground. (c) Away Matches: On payment of the requisite ground admission charge and subject to accommodation being available, admission to the Pavilion or Members' enclosures on any ground where Middlesex are playing, entirely at the discretion of the home venue.

### 2. Vitality Blast

GROUP MATCHES – Privileges as noted in (1a). Please note that if you wish to take a guest into the Pavilion you must purchase in advance from the MCC a Pavilion Admission Ticket (maximum of ONE) for your guest. Pavilion admission tickets are subject to availability and it is advisable to purchase in advance (on sale from 4 March 2019). If you wish to take guest(s) into the Members' Friends' Enclosures you must purchase each guest a Rover Ticket (maximum of FOUR) from MCC. The seating in these areas will be unreserved. For tickets please call 020 7432 1000.

KNOCKOUT ROUNDS - Members are required to pay the requisite amount for the quarter-finals, semi-finals and final.

Please Note: County level members do not get members privileges for any T20 Blast matches, Junior & Teen members are unable to purchase Pavilion Admission or Rover Tickets. (See Note vi).

**3. Royal London One Day Cup** Home Matches: The privilege referred to in (1a).Away Matches: The privilege referred to in (1c).

### MAJOR MATCH PRIVLEGES AT LORD'S

Middlesex members are granted special privileges by MCC for some of the major matches at Lord's. Details of these benefits are as follows:



- Fifth Day of Investec Test Matches: On production of a current Middlesex Membership card containing a photograph, you'll be granted admission to the Members' and Friends' Enclosures, after payment of the ground admission charge.
- Royal London One-Day Cup Final (Saturday 25th May). Middlesex members (excluding Junior Members) will be granted admission to the Members' and Friends' Enclosures and to the Lord's Pavilion on production of a current Middlesex Membership card containing a photograph, after purchasing a Rover Ticket in advance from the Lord's Ticket Office on 020 7432 1000. Please note that special consideration would need to be given to the arrangements in the event that Middlesex reached the final.

### PRIORITY TEST MATCH APPLICATION FORMS FOR 2019

Priority Test Match Application Forms are available to all Middlesex members (excluding Junior & Teen members). All you need to do to take advantage of this benefit is the following:

- Send a stamped (Large Letter stamp) and self-addressed C4 envelope (equivalent to an A4 sheet of paper) into the Middlesex office, with your membership number clearly marked on the envelope.
- Ideally you should send your envelope in to us between the months of July and November for the following season's Test matches, as we usually receive the Priority Applications Forms from MCC at the end of November each year.
- As soon as we have received the forms from MCC, they will be sent to you if we have received an envelope from you as specified above. Application forms are sent out on a first come first served basis. MCC issues Test Match tickets to Middlesex members for a limited period, normally at the end of November/early December, prior to tickets being opened up to a public ballot.

### OTHER MATCHES AT LORD'S

Members are entitled to enter the Ground at the Grace Gates on payment of the requisite ground admission charges and are also permitted to enter the Members' Friends' Enclosures (subject to availability).

Entirely at the discretion of MCC, Middlesex members will be permitted to enter the Pavilion and members' areas during MCC matches. Full details will be available on notice boards and on the website during each season. Middlesex members are not entitled to introduce guests into the Pavilion for these matches. (See Notes i & vi).

### NOTES

(i) Members' Friends' Enclosures comprise the Warner Stand, the Tavern and the Allen Stand (subject to availability and restrictions). It is regretted that for International Matches the privilege for members of admission to Members' Enclosures is NOT available. (ii) The members' dining room is Pelham's in the Warner Stand.
(iii) All guests must pay the requisite ground admission charge. The privilege of introducing guests applies only to those home matches referred to in (1a) and (1b) and not in One-Day Finals.

(iv) The introduction of a guest to the Pavilion must be made by the Member in person who must sign and enter the name of his/ her guest in the Visitors' Book provided. Juniors under 12 years of age may not be introduced. Junior members are not permitted to introduce guests into the Pavilion. Members must accompany their guests in the Pavilion. Guests must leave the Pavilion when the Member themselves leave.

(v) On production of his/her current Membership Card, Full Members are admitted free of charge to the Ground, Pavilion, and Members' Friends' Enclosures for all Middlesex Matches except the quarter-finals, semi-finals & finals of the T20 Blast and the Royal London One-Day Cup. This is subject to any restriction, or exception, which MCC may consider necessary from time to time. (vi) Subject to alteration or withdrawal without prior notice.
