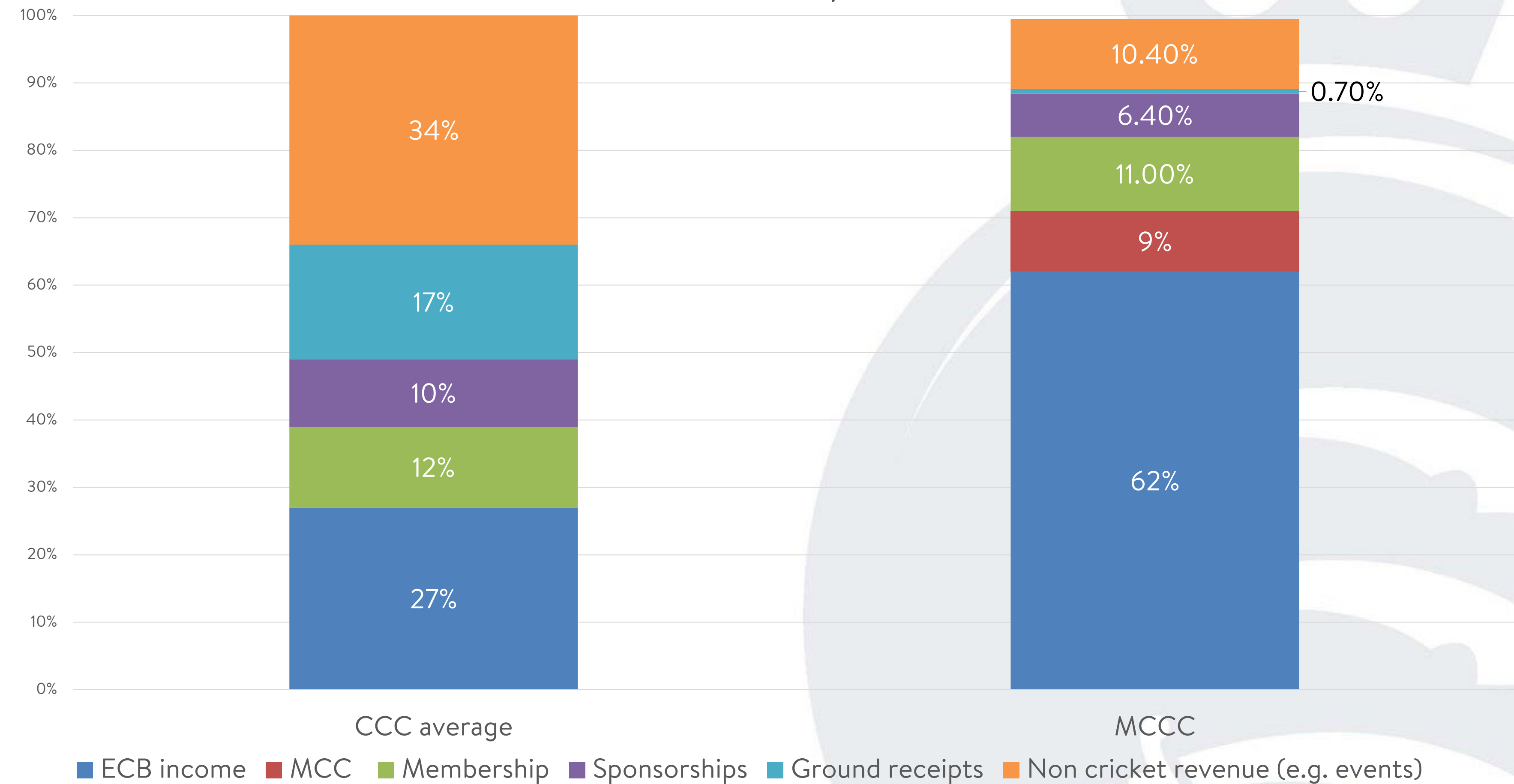

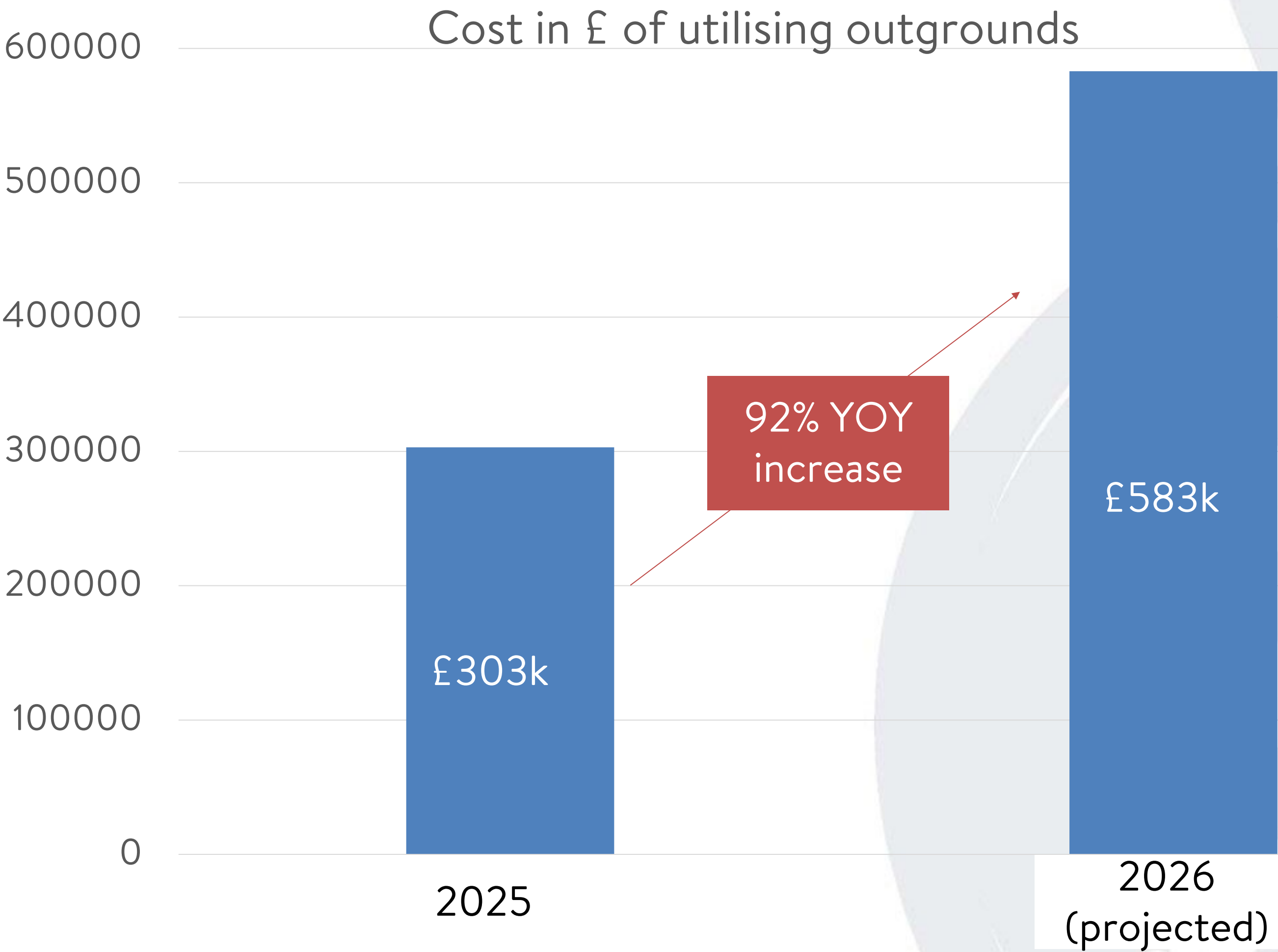


# Revenue derived from ECB vs. other sources

- £100k+ is considered the benchmark for high quality domestic talent – on average the highest spenders will have ~10
- Salary expenditure for 2025 £1.398m, average salary £66.5k
- With 3 x rookies and 6 U21s / players in their early 20s MCCC are one of the younger squads

- All clubs are restricted in their use of proceeds from the Hundred sale.
- Funds cannot be used for salaries or signings
- ECB permission must be sought, with access restricted to the following categories:

- **Revenue generating projects** is the only option available to us at present, aside from **building out financial reserves**.
